House Bill 22-1107 created an Inclusive Higher Education Grant Program that allows colleges across the state to apply for needed funding to develop inclusive college pathways for students with intellectual disabilities (ID).

INCLUSIVE HIGHER EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM - ROUND 3

- Funded by <u>HB 22-1107</u> & <u>CDHE</u>
- Administered by <u>IN!</u>, a 501c3
- Intended for state institutions of higher education wishing to create *new* inclusive college programs for students with intellectual disabilities.
- This grant cycle will focus specifically on funding programs in rural, Western Slope and Community College settings.
- 5 years of grant funding, including 1 year dedicated to program planning and development.
