

# General Independence Supports

- Person Centered Planning
- Specialized Class / Direct Instruction:
  - Money management
  - Community access & travel training
  - Self-advocacy development
- Environment of choice & natural consequences
- Peer mentor guidance in:
  - o use of down time
  - calendar tracking system
  - use of natural supports



# Residential Living Supports

- Year 1-2, room with peers from program
- Scheduled support from peer mentors:
  - o cleaning/chores
  - o grocery shopping/cooking
  - o roommate conflict
- Natural support from residential staff
  - o RA/RD
- Additional support from program staff as needed
- Use of waiver services as needed


