
Colorado offers 8 inclusive higher education (IHE) options

Designed for Students Who:

- Have a documented intellectual disability with need for additional support in academic, career, social, and independent skills
- Do not meet traditional college entrance criteria and/or would benefit from modifications in order to fully access college coursework
- Have a desire to go to college
- Express interest in living and working as independently as possible after college
- Have completed K-12 education (students <u>may</u> participate in their district transition or 18-21 program before starting inclusive programs)
- Are able to participate in class and campus activities with support
- Wish to pursue a certificate credential

Students in Inclusive Higher Ed:

- Declare a primary area of study
- Utilize academic accommodations and modifications of coursework
- Follow an individualized plan of study to include 2-3 courses/semester
- Receive robust support through direct advising, peer mentors, and the school's office of inclusive higher education
- Are fully included in college courses, taken for credit with high standards that align with persondriven plan (PDP)
- Experience full campus engagement, including events, clubs, residential options, and more
- Participate in person-driven planning regarding academic and vocational goal-setting
- Engage in a progression of job experiences, including on-campus and off-campus employment
- Earn a Comprehensive Higher Education Certificate from the institution
- Participate in commencement exercises upon completion
